If you do not understand any of the details below or in the form, do NOT be put off; just apply. The Trustees want to see as many applications as possible and can come back to you if they need further information.

1. Applicants must be of school age and under twenty-five years at the date of the meeting at which their application is considered.
2. Applicants must have lived in the Cheddar Civil Parish, for at least 12 months prior to the date of the meeting at which their application is considered
3. Applicants will normally be restricted to one application in any 12 months period.
4. Further Information:- Include as many details of your activity or project as you can. This will help the Trustees.
5. Interviews:- In one or two cases, applicants may be asked to attend an interview with Trustees.

The Four Main Objectives of this Trust:

A few ideas, as examples only, to assist you in completing your application:

1. To assist young people in their educational, professional, or vocational training.

You may need books or equipment for your course of study or training, or have a special talent, which will benefit from additional specialist teaching or coaching.

2. To encourage and assist such young people to engage in service to the community or other worthwhile activity in the Cheddar area, or in other parts of the United Kingdom, or overseas.

You may want to work here in Cheddar, or away from home and maybe abroad, in assisting those who are old or ill or handicapped, or you may want to do such things as Voluntary Service Overseas, or take part in Operation Raleigh.

3. To support the development or formation of any club or organisation catering for young people.

You may wish to take some responsibility for getting a club off the ground, or help to develop a group activity.

4. To help where real need can be demonstrated.
